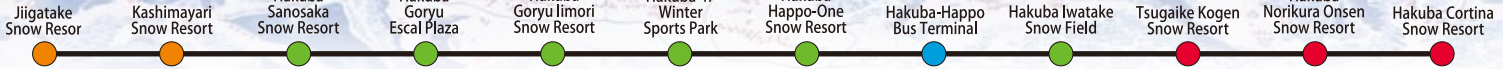

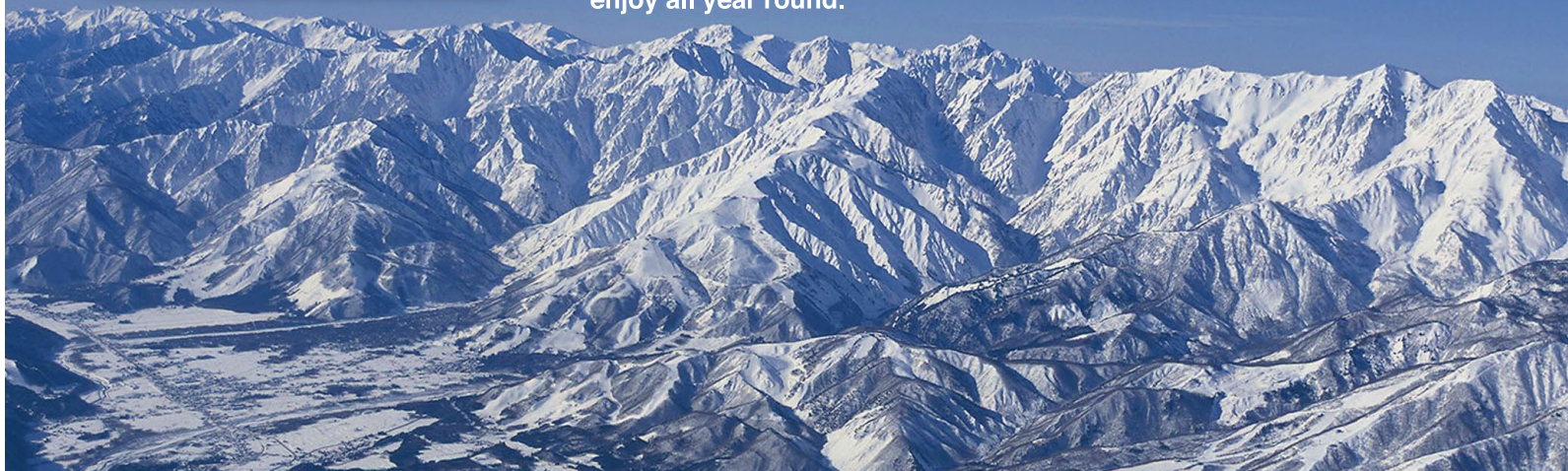


about HAKUBA VALLEY

The Winter Season

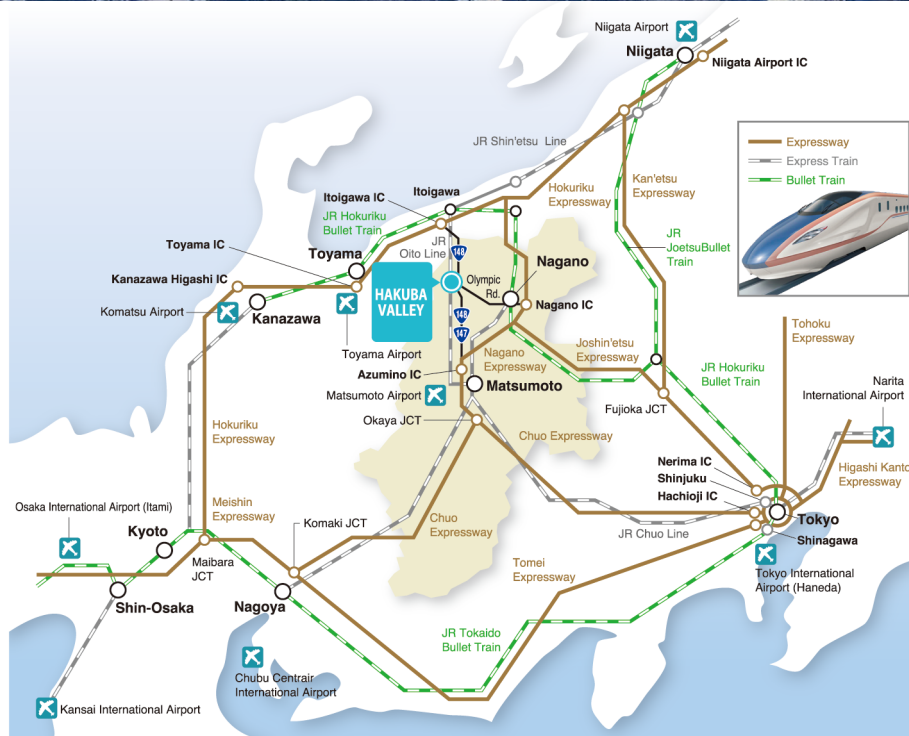
